<b>Agua Caliente Reservation</b>	In 1927, Henry Wadsworth submitted 50 allotments to the Secretary of the Interior under the GAA, but the Secretary disapproved the allotments because of objections from some of the Indians. Two lawsuits followed to have the allotments made. In 1944, the Supreme Court held that the Secretary must make the allotments.
